General Description

Under the supervision and direction of the principal/director the student support counselor provides school-based counseling services for students referred by teachers and with written parent consent. Provides supportive and direct services to students with problem behaviors that interfere with academic performance, developmental progress, or cause conflict with peers and/or adults. Friendship groups, parent or teacher consultation, classroom social emotional lessons may also be part of duties.

Minimum Qualifications

1. Prefer possession of a valid California Pupil Personnel Services Credential or license as a Clinical Social Worker (LCSW) or a Marriage, Family Therapist (MFT).
2. Experience working in school setting or counseling youth.
3. Demonstrate competence in communicating effectively with children, parents, staff members and representatives of other agencies.

The program duration will be Tuesday-Thursday 11:45-12:15 (approximately 4 hours/3 days week) for 36 weeks beginning in September and ending in June (excluding school vacation weeks).

This position is either certificated or classified depending on qualifications. The rate of pay is \$35.96 per hour for the 2022-23 school year. This position does not participate in health and welfare, unless the employee is .65 FTE or better at a combination of schools and there is a sponsoring school.
