Our family understands that we are expected to follow USC guidelines for protecting ourselves and the campus community during this pandemic. We will do our part to make our campus a safe and healthy environment.

- We will follow all current precautions regarding travel, exposure, gatherings, quarantine, etc. as dictated by county and state public health officials.*
 - If we are unable to follow those precautions for any reason, we will quarantine for 10 days prior to returning to campus.
- We will perform daily wellness self-checks and symptom checklist before coming onto campus.
- We will stay off campus if a family member is sick or if we have been in contact with someone with COVID-19.
- My child/ren will wear a face covering any time they are on campus, per state requirements.
- My child/ren will follow instructions for cleaning and hygiene on campus. My child/ren will wash their hands frequently with soap and water. When soap and water are not available, they will use hand sanitizer.
- My child/ren will practice social distancing as requested by USC staff members.
- We will promptly follow directions from Humboldt County Public Health (related to travel, testing and contact tracing).
